The case was referred to Dr Tareq Rahimi who performed surgery under the local block with the help of FMIC anaesthesia Head Dr Rashad Ahmad Akbari. This happened to be the first neurosurgery procedure in Afghanistan with a normal level of consciousness.

On the second day of surgery, Barlayali smiled and gradually started moving. He is now walking normally. Shir Alam could not believe this but his emotions were telling the story. With a sigh of relief and sense of hope-he thanked FMIC and La Chaine for a miraculous treatment yet free of cost!
